Dr. Martin LeBoldus High School is located in the city of Regina, Saskatchewan (2330-25th Avenue) in the south end of the city. It is a publicly funded Catholic High School that is one of four secondary schools in the Regina Catholic School Division. The school opened its doors in January, 1976 and it is currently a dual track school (English Stream and French Immersion Stream) with approximately 795 registered students (grades 9, 10, 11, and 12) and 55 staff members. The school takes its name from the late Dr. Martin LeBoldus, a respected medical doctor in the community, and a long-time member of the Regina Catholic School Board.

Goals and Learning Improvement Plan:

- Focus on integrating Catholic faith into all aspects of school life.
- Continue to foster a multicultural environment that focuses on inclusion of all, with a central emphasis on respect, tolerance and fairness.
- Focus on a concentrated use of literacy skills across all subject areas.

School Successes!

We offer programming to meet the needs of all students in our school. We currently offer modified opportunities at all grade levels as well as Advanced Placement classes at the grade 12 level in the areas of Language Arts, Calculus, Computer Science, Psychology, and Visual Arts (with challenge options for Core French and Spanish). Successful completion of Advanced Placement classes will result in students receiving Advanced Placement designation on Ministry of Education transcripts and possible university credit.

Our students are able to take part in a full range of interscholastic athletic activities and LeBoldus has a long tradition of city and provincial championship teams. We also have a number of outstanding fine arts programs, including Choral, Vocal Jazz, Band, Jazz Band, and Visual Arts. We produce one major drama production yearly, participate in the improv games annually (as well as other improv events), and we have many other clubs that our students can join (debate, the environment, and social justice to name a few).

In all programming (academics, sports, and fine arts), our students have excelled. LeBoldus graduates annually are awarded well over \$100,000 in scholarship money, and our graduates have attended universities throughout Canada and the United States.
