

Policy 11 – Board Delegation of Authority

The Board authorizes the Director to exercise any power that the Board may or is required to do, except those matters, which in accordance with provincial legislation, cannot be delegated.

Notwithstanding the above, the Board also reserves to itself the authority to make decisions on matters requiring Board approval in accordance with specific Board policies. Furthermore, the Board requires that any new provincial, regional or local initiatives must be initially brought to the Board for discussion, and determination of decision-making authority.

Specifically,

1. The Director is directed to develop an administrative application to fulfill the Board obligations created by federal, provincial or local legislations, which are not covered through Board policy.
2. The Board authorizes the payment of accounts for expenditures incurred within the approved Budget or specific Board decisions and in accordance with Board policy and generally accepted accounting principles, and delegates to the Director or designate responsibility for certification of such payments.
