Preamble

The Regina Catholic School Division (RCSD) strives to maintain a quality indoor environment in all of its buildings. Scented products can aggravate existing health problems for students and staff members who have asthma, allergies, and other medical conditions. The Saskatchewan Health Authority recommends that scented personal care products be used sparingly. Health problems such as congestion, wheezing, sore throat, runny nose, shortness of breath and headache result from exposure to such odours or scents.

Application

Steps towards creating a quality indoor scent-alert environment:

1. At the beginning of each school year the principal shall address the benefits of having a scent-alert environment with students, staff and parents.
2. At the beginning of the school year the principal shall review administrative applications and school procedures regarding Scent-Alert with the school staff and Catholic School Community Councils.
3. The principal shall display Regina Catholic School Division Scent-Alert signs that welcome visitors to their scent-alert school environment.
