Preamble

City of Regina Bylaw No. 10167 bans smoking in educational institutions. This bylaw is supported by the *Public Health Act, 1994,* and *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984.*

Application

The use of tobacco, e-cigarettes, vaporizers and related products in the Regina Catholic School Division (RCSD) are subject to applicable laws, by-laws, and regulations pursuant to this administrative application.

- 1. All school division property and facilities are free of tobacco, tobacco products, smokeless tobacco, environmental smoke, e-cigarettes, and vaporizers or other smoking alternatives on our property.
- 2. The use of tobacco products or environmental smoke for religious or ceremonial purposes must be approved by the Director (e.g. sweet grass, burning of palms).
