Preamble

Students of the Regina Catholic School Division (RCSD) participating in scheduled inter-school athletic programs shall do so in accordance with regulations pursuant to this administrative application.

Definitions

- Informed Parent Consent**
For the purpose of this application, “informed parent consent” involves a waiver signed by parents, indicating consent for a student to participate in an inter-scholastic athletic activity. This waiver would include a brief explanation of the athletic activity involved.
- Inter-Scholastic Athletic Activities**
For the purpose of this application, “inter-scholastic athletic activities” refers to all regularly scheduled, school sponsored extra-curricular athletic activities involving students from other schools.
- Non-Adult High School Student**
For the purpose of this application, a “non-adult high school student” is any student who has not yet reached the age of eighteen (18) years of age at the time of the commencement of the inter-scholastic activity for which informed consent is required.

Application

- High school students participating in Regina High School Athletic Association (RHSAA) sanctioned activities shall meet all requirements of the RHSAA as a condition of their involvement.
- Informed parent consent is required for:
 - Non-adult high school students participating in inter-scholastic athletic activities not sanctioned by the RHSAA.
 - Elementary school students participating in inter-scholastic athletic activities.
