Dear Families and Supporters of Regina Catholic Schools,

For nearly 20 years, our Catholic Education Centre staff has been experiencing space pressures. We have managed by adding workspaces, we have some staff offices at St. Peter School, and three full departments are in office space at Miller Comprehensive Catholic High School. When we look at our projected enrollment, we will grow by 2,700 students by 2030; our schools need their spaces back.

In an effort to find a facility that can hold all our central staff appropriately, the Board is exploring other facility options.

A larger facility will positively impact RCSD operations by effectively addressing staff needs through a functional workspace; optimizing school buildings for learning; eliminating significant travel costs associated with having staff in different locations; consolidating administrative functions in one location; and supporting staff collaboration. This would allow us to prioritize school space for students and improve the efficiency of administration in supporting our goals and commitments to students and families.

Costs associated with a different facility would be offset by the sales of the current Archdiocesan offices (former St. Anne School), École du Parc (former École St. Andrew), as well as the current Catholic Education Centre.

To date no final decision has been made and we continue to seek suitable opportunities. As details become finalized we will continue to keep our school communities engaged and informed.
