
Preamble

The Regina Catholic School Division (RCSD) is committed to fostering an environment that promotes Catholicism and academic and professional success in all students and staff. The achievement of such success is dependent on an environment free of behaviours which could undermine the mission of the school division and the public they serve. The mission is “to work with the community and local church to provide quality Catholic Education that fosters academic excellence and the development of informed responsible citizens”.

An atmosphere of mutual respect, collegiality, fairness, and trust is essential. All members of the school division will conduct themselves in an ethical and professional manner at all times; with Catholic teachings and values guiding their actions. RCSD requires all trustees and employees to follow their contract, conditions of employment and/or professional organization guidelines as set out by the appropriate governing body.

Application

1. This Code of Conduct applies to all RCSD trustees. It is the duty of the director to ensure the Code of Conduct is reviewed annually with each trustee.
2. Trustees shall ensure they are following the practices and teachings of the Catholic Church.
3. Trustees shall abide by the Education Act, Board policies and SSBA practices.
4. Trustees shall give foremost consideration to all staff and students' wellbeing.
5. Trustees shall conduct themselves in a professional manner and treat all members of the school division community with dignity and respect.
6. Trustees shall serve the stakeholder group(s) in their area of work.
7. If a person wishes to report non-compliance with code of conduct, process is to forward concerns to Director for follow-up.
