Preamble

The Regina Catholic School Division (RCSD) is committed to providing a work environment free of intoxicating substances. The division restricts the use of intoxicating substances on school division premises.

Application

RCSD expects that any use of intoxicating substances in school division facilities operate in accordance with applicable laws and Board policy.

- 1. Intoxicating substances shall not be sold, served, consumed, or displayed in any school division facility.
- 2. Alcohol may be used in high school food services programs and in related food preparation providing that it is kept in a secure location accessible only to school division staff.
- 3. Staff shall not have any intoxicating substances on school property.
- 4. The Master Facilities Joint Use Agreement between RCSD and the City of Regina shall prohibit the selling, serving, consuming, display, or use of alcoholic beverages in any manner by user groups.
- 5. Wine to be used in the celebration of the Mass is allowed on school premises but must be maintained in a secure location accessible only to school division staff.
