Application

Inter-scholastic athletic activities involving travel outside of the City of Regina shall proceed as follows:

1. Senior Athletics

Subject to approval of the principal and designated senior administrator:

- Teams may travel to one (1) out-of-province event.
- Teams may travel to one (1) in-province event outside the City of Regina.
- Teams may participate in as many tournaments within the City of Regina as deemed appropriate by the principal and within RHSAA guidelines. *As per RHSAA guidelines, Balgonie Greenall, Lumsden will be considered in-city travel for exhibition play and/or tournament play.
- Teams may use a maximum of four (4) school days in a season to attend tournaments and associated tournament activities.
- Teams intending to travel outside of the country require preliminary approval of the principal and designated superintendent before planning commences.
- Time used by teams for hosting tournaments will not count against 1 (d).
- Participation in regional and provincial championship competition will be viewed as a special circumstance and such travel shall be in addition to 1 (b) and will not count against 1 (d).
- Exceptions to these applications may be made at the request of the principal and with the approval of the designated superintendent.

2. Junior Athletics

Subject to the approval of the principal and the designated superintendent:

- Teams may travel to one (1) in-province event outside of the City of Regina.
- Teams may participate in as many tournaments within the City of Regina as deemed appropriate by the principal and within RHSAA guidelines. *As per RHSAA

guidelines, Balgonie Greenall and Lumsden will be considered in city travel for tournament and exhibition play.

- c. Teams may use a maximum of four (4) school days in a season to attend tournaments and associated tournament activities.
- d. Time used by teams for hosting tournaments will not be counted against 1(d).
- e. Exceptions to these applications may be made at the request of the principal and with the approval of the designated superintendent.

3. Elementary Athletics

- a. Elementary school teams will not be involved with out of city, inter-provincial, or international events.
- b. Exceptions to these guidelines may be made at the request of the principal and with the approval of the designated superintendent.
