Preamble

The Board shall provide students in each high school with annual awards for Catholic leadership, general proficiency, and merit. Board Awards are provided in accordance with regulations pursuant to this administrative application.

The Board provides funding and sponsorship for the following awards:

- 1. The Catholic Leadership Award
- 2. The Regina Catholic School Board Proficiency Award
- 3. The Indigenous Student Achievement Award

Application

This application outlines general criteria for the awards noted above.

1. The Catholic Leadership Award - \$500

This Board-sponsored award is given to the Grade 12 student who

- a. has demonstrated Catholic leadership at both the school and parish level,
- b. has demonstrated a care and concern for others through his or her actions, attitudes, and commitments toward school, parish, and community, and
- c. has a positive attitude toward students, staff, and the school to such an extent that it has earned for the individual the respect of students and staff.

2. The Regina Catholic School Board Proficiency Award - \$500

This Board-sponsored award is given to the student who has achieved the highest academic average based on criteria developed at each high school.

3. The Indigenous Student Achievement Award - \$500

This Board-sponsored award is given to a graduating student of Indigenous Ancestry who

- a. has good academic standing,
- b. is involved in extra-curricular and/or activities in the Indigenous community,



- c. has worked for or plans to work for the betterment of Indigenous peoples,
- d. plans to continue his/her education at a post-secondary institution.

4. Funding of Awards

Funding of awards is determined by the Board, on an annual basis.

5. Presentation of Awards

A Board Trustee will present the Board award.
