Application

- Sponsorship (payment of fees) for online courses offered by the Regina Catholic School Division (RCSD) will be extended to students registered in a high school within the school division;
 - a. if the school timetable cannot accommodate classes required to meet the student's needs
 - b. (subject to principal's approval), or
 - c. if a student is homebound, or
 - d. if a student is homeschooled, subject to provisions in Administrative Application 8100 Home Based Education, or
 - e. if a student has a genuine interest in exploring online learning as an alternative learning experience and/or to provide flexibility within their timetable.
- 2. Sponsorship for online courses offered by RCSD will not be extended in situations where;
 - a. the student does not have prior permission from the principal, or
 - b. the student wishes to take additional credits beyond five (5) credits in any one semester, unless the student has an average of 80% or better, and wishes to take one (1) additional online course (subject to principal's approval).
- 3. Students may request online courses through the Saskatchewan Distance Learning Corporation (Sask DLC.) Sponsorship for these courses will be offered only in cases where the desired courses are not offered by RCSD Learning Online.
- 4. Students who drop all in-class high school courses and who remain in an online course must maintain registration within the school division.
