## **Preamble**

In any emergency, the safety of students is of paramount importance. In the event of a civil or natural disaster, or other immediate and life-threatening situation, the principal is authorized to evacuate the school in the interests of student safety and well-being in accordance with the Regina Catholic School Division (RCSD) Emergency Response Guide for School Administrators.

## **Application**

- 1. Principals shall develop emergency procedures for the evacuation of the school.
- 2. Principals shall provide for the regular review of evacuation procedures to ensure that students, staff, and parents are thoroughly familiar with them.
- 3. When the procedures for each school have been established, a copy of the procedures shall be filed with the designated superintendent.
