<p>Nurturing Catholic Ethos</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • October fundraiser for Holy Childhood Association- hat days/ pyjama days every Friday in October- no total yet but will be able to make a respectable donation. Thanks Griffons Families! • Opening Mass with Father Chris was held virtually on October 7th, along with our 2 Kindergarten Welcome Liturgies (Deacon Joe Lang officiated the morning liturgy) • Monday morning virtual assemblies each week • Praying the “Hail Mary” every morning for the month of October • Continue to emphasize kindness and understanding in COVID times!
<p>Academics</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our current enrolment is 468 students in 19 classrooms; COVID-19 shutdown and online learning enrolment have affected numbers. • Reading interventions in place in Grades 2-5 right now- all hands on deck! Daily small-group literacy sessions are happening at these levels. • Knowledgehook/ Mathletics are being used in classrooms. • Assessment/ evidence of learning being shared in Seesaw • “Vote etudiant” happening this week (Thursday and Friday)- to coincide with provincial and municipal election
<p>Safe and Orderly Environment</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SWPBIS kick-off was held at the beginning of the month; so far we have seen amazing levels of student buy-in with our behavior matrix and tickets. Staff have supported SWPBIS by recognizing and celebrating positive behaviours in the school. • Change to cleaning protocols after staining was happening with Vital oxide spray- have had no further reports of damaged clothing; • Site visit with our Facilities Comptroller on Friday the 16th; a few projects for the school (cosmetic mostly)- although we did discuss signage for the staff parking lot. • Students are being very cooperative with mitigating procedures- staggered lunch/ recess, bathroom, physical distancing, etc.
<p>Quality Relationships</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Father Chris very eager to connect with our staff and students; we continue to promote activities of Holy Family Parish- upcoming: KC Christmas Poster Contest; EDGE meetings monthly (virtual). • Three-way conferences will be November 25th and 26th; Friday the 27th the school will be closed as it will be a day in lieu for staff. • Shout out to our parents who are being incredibly supportive of illness protocols and following directions of SaskHealth!
