RE: Regina School Immunization Pilot Project – January 2019

We are writing to update you that the immunizations you have consented to for your child to receive in school this year will be provided by a team of Registered Nurses (RNs) and Licenced Practical Nurses (LPNs). As the Saskatchewan Health Authority moves towards having appropriately trained health teams providing services in all settings, LPNs will be joining the immunization team to work in schools for the first time. Other provinces have used this team design for a number of years with great success, so we are excited to pilot it also in your child's school.

The Saskatchewan Association of Licensed Practical Nurses (SALPN), Saskatchewan Registered Nurses Association (SRNA) and the Registered Psychiatric Nurses Association of Saskatchewan (RPNAS) support the collaboration of health care providers to promote high functioning teams – providing immunizations is an approved practice for all of these providers.
