Parking:

- Buses will drop off and pick up students on the south side of Albulet Dr. Please do not park in this designated area.
- If you're dropping off or picking up students, use James Hill Rd., Albulet Dr. and Aerodrome Rd. Please note there are a number of no-stopping zones near fire hydrants, bus drop-off and pick-up zones and the crosswalks. If you park on the north side of Albulet Dr., remind your child to cross at the corner of James Hill and Albulet Dr. We do not want students trying to cross between buses.
- Please don't park in the staff parking lot when dropping off your child at the beginning or end of the day.
- There are three designated spots in the staff parking lot for those attending meetings at the school or picking up sick children during the day.

Dress & Appearance

As a Catholic school, we want to help our students understand modesty is an essential part of who we are and what we represent. Students are expected to dress in appropriate clothing that is suitable for the weather and represents the values we express in our Catholic faith. Clothing such as muscle shirts, open backs, spaghetti straps, bare midriffs, short skirts/shorts, and bandannas are not allowed. In general, students will be expected to have a clean appearance that is reasonable, modest, decent and respectable.

Emergency Drills

In the next few weeks, we will be practicing our emergency drills along with the YMCA and École Harbour Landing. In preparation for our drills, staff will spend time reviewing procedures.

Student Placement Requests

We will soon start placing students into classes for the next school year. Assigning students to specific classrooms is a joint process involving classroom teachers, learning resource teachers and administration. There are a number of factors considered when student placements are determined. They include the following:

- the number of students per grade
- gender and age of the student
- academic needs and work habits
- social/emotional aspects
- peer relationships

Using our professional judgment, the staff team makes the best decisions possible for all students involved. We do however appreciate being made aware of **significant** student needs and concerns. Placing 550 students is a complex task and our priority is to ensure optimum learning environments. The information you share is confidential.
