Art classes led by our Parish Youth Coordinator, Dawna DeCorby, for children and youth aged 8 to 18 are planned for every Monday in July and August here at St. Peter Parish (100 Argyle Street) in the Parish Hall. Students will explore colour and learn to paint with acrylics.

A registration form is attached (next page). A fee of \$20/child or \$40/family is payable to St. Peter Parish, and the deadline for registering is Friday, June 28. **Class space is limited; only the first 20 registrations forms can be accepted.** It is important that a parent or other caregiver be available to pick a child up at any time during classes in case of sickness or other unforeseen need, so please include complete contact details on the form.

Once registration forms are in, Dawna will discuss with parents what time of day on Monday works best for everyone. Depending on how many apply, there may be two classes, one on Monday, and one on another day of the week. There will be classes even on statutory holidays.

**Parents/grandparents/etc. are always welcome** to accompany and help out if they wish. **We may, if necessary, ask each family to commit to providing a volunteer to attend, and help out if needed, on a certain day.** A schedule of volunteers will be drawn up and provided.

It is understood that not everyone will be able to attend all the classes throughout the summer. Families take vacations; children have camps. No worries.

I consent to the use of photographs and video footage, including images of the Participant, taken during the classes, for the purpose of promoting similar future events. This release and covenant not to sue shall be effective and binding on my personal representatives, heirs and assigns, and those of the Participant.
