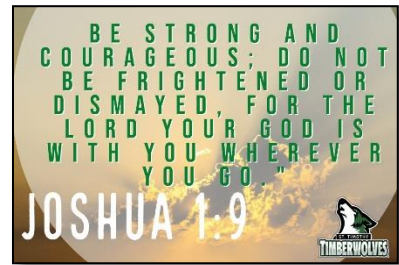


Moving forward we continue to be diligent in our return to school plan which includes daily cleaning of school spaces and high touch points, grouping of students by homeroom, gathering zones for the morning, staggered recesses and lunch, washing and sanitizing of hands and mask wearing. All of these measures were put together in an easy way for students and have

appeared in our last few school letters. We also understand that the school is but one aspect of the lives of students and that other activities and contacts are factors in the health we experience at St Timothy. With this we thank the community for being diligent in their own safety measures and for some of the social sacrifices being made at this time.



If/when another case is detected at the school we will respond to close contact students and their families personally and offer as much information as possible within the collective idea that 'we will get through this together'. Teachers are ready to pivot should any classroom move to remote learning and for a two week span students would have regular curricular assignments and tasks. After this period all students would be welcomed back with the expectation of regular attendance unless otherwise stated from the Saskatchewan Health Authority.



St Timothy will continue to do its part and we ask that families continue to practice personal safety measures and be diligent in carrying out the daily screening questionnaire: for the safety of our school relies on the safety of the community.
